St. Clair County Transit District to Address Safety Issues on Local Transit System

St. Clair County Transit District (SCCTD) today announced it is partnering with **Chestnut Health Systems**™, a not-for-profit health and human services organization, to launch a one-year pilot program to help address problematic behaviors on the local transit system. SCCTD is investing nearly \$200,000 in this effort, which will enable mental health advisors to work alongside SCCTD Ambassadors, the St. Clair County Sheriff's Department and Metro Transit Public Safety to mitigate the number of behavioral incidences.
